The International Day of Drug Checking is celebrated on 31st March every year since 2017.

Odisha Day or Utkal Divas- 1st April 2022:

The foundation day of Odisha, known as Odisha Day, or Utkal Diwas will be observed on 1st
 April.

International Children's Book Day-April 2

• International Children's Book Day (ICBD) is orgainsed every year on April 2 since 1967, by the International Board on Books for Young People (IBBY) - an international non-profit organisation.

World Autism Awareness Day- April 2, 2022

- World Autism Awareness Day is observed on April 2, every year to make people understand and accept people with autism, foster worldwide support, and inspire people.
- It is a day that spread kindness and autism awareness.

International Day for Mine Awareness and Assistance in Mine Action:

• The General Assembly approved the decision on December 8, 2005, and declared April 4 of each year to be observed as the International Day for Mine Awareness and Assistance in Mine Action.

National Maritime Day- 5th April:

- National Maritime Day is annually observed on April 5, 2022.
- The theme of National Maritime Day 2022 is 'Sustainable Shipping beyond Covid-19'.

United Nations International Day of Conscience:

• The General Assembly of the United Nations agreed in 2019 to declare April 5th the International Day of Conscience, with the aim of creating conditions of stability and well-being and

relationships based on respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms for all, without distinction based on race, sex, language or religion.

International Day of Sport for Development and Peace:

• The International Day of Sport for Development and Peace (IDSDP), which takes place annually on 6 April, presents an opportunity to recognize the positive role sport and physical activity play in communities and in people's lives across the globe.

World Health Day-April 7th

- April 7 is celebrated and observed as World Health Day.
- The theme for this year's World Health Day is "Our Planet, Our Health".

International Day of Reflection on the 1994 Genocide in Rwanda:

- The International Day of Reflection on the 1994 Rwandan Genocide was recognized as an international observance by the United Nations on April 7, 2004.
- International Day of Reflection on the 1994 Genocide against the Tutsi in Rwanda is commemorated by UNESCO

CRPF Valour Day-9th April:

- On April 9th, the Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) celebrates Valour Day (Shaurya Diwas) to tribute to the Force's courteous personnel.
- The 57th CRPF Valour Day will be held in 2022.

World Homeopathy Day-10th April:

- World Homeopathy Day is observed annually on April 10 to commemorate Dr Samuel Hahnemann's birth anniversary.
- This year, the theme for World Homeopathy Day 2022 in India is "People's Choice For Wellness"

International Day of Human Space Flight -12 April

- The United Nations (UN) celebrates the International Day of Human Space Flight on April 12
 each year.
- The day remembers the first human space flight on April 12, 1961.

National Safe Motherhood Day-April 11

- National Safe Motherhood Day is observed every year on April 11.
- It is aimed at raising awareness about the care that a pregnant woman needs before, during, and after childbirth.

World Parkinson's Day 2022:

- World Parkinson's Day belongs to the Parkinson's community.
- This year, on 11 April, Parkinson's UK is supporting 2 activities, chosen and led by a group of dedicated and passionate volunteers: Poems for Parkinson's and Light Up Blue for Parkinson's.

International Turban Day-April 13:

- International Turban Day, observed annually on April 13th since 2004, is an occasion that celebrates Sikh Identity.
- The 2022 Turban Day marks the 553rd birth anniversary of Guru Nanak Dev and the festival of Baisakhi.

38th Siachen Day -13 April:

• The Siachen Warriors celebrated the 37th Siachen Day on 13th April 2021 to honour the soldiers of the Indian army who continue to guard the Siachen Glacier, the northern frontier which is a part of the Union Territory of Ladakh.

Am bedkar Jayanti -14 April

- April 14 is marked as Ambedkar Jayanti to honour Dr Ambedkar's countless contributions in the making of present-day India.
- Ambedkar is known as the Father (chief architect) of the Indian Constitution.
- He was the first Law and Justice Minister of the country after the independence.
- Dr Bhim has been bestowed with the country's highest civilian honour, Bharat Ratna in 1990 posthumously.

World Chagas Disease Day - 14 April

- To raise awareness about a life-threatening disease that can cause serious heart and digestive issues,
 every year April 14 is observed as World Chagas Day.
- It is often termed a "silent and silenced disease"
- World Chagas Disease Day was first observed on April 14, 2020
- April 14 was chosen to mark the day as the first case of Chagas disease in a human was reported on this
 day in 1990.

World Art Day - 15th April

- World Art Day is observed every year on 15 April globally.
- World Art Day was first declared in 2019 during the 40th session of UNESCO's General Conference.
- The day also marks the birth anniversary of the famous Renaissance polymath Leonardo da Vinci.

Himachal Pradesh statehood Day- 15th April:

- April 15 is observed as Himachal Day.
- Four districts of Mandi, Chamba, Mahasu and Sirmour were integrated with over two dozen princely states, leading to the formation of Himachal Pradesh as a Union Territory in 1948.

World Voice Day 2022:

- Every year on April 16, the world celebrates World Voice Day.
- This day is commemorated to raise awareness and education about the value of speaking in our daily lives.
- On April 16, 1999, the Brazilian Society of Laryngology and Voice, chaired by Dr. Nedio Steffen, declared the day as Brazilian Voice Day.

Save the Elephant Day: 16 April

- Every year, Save the Elephant Day is celebrated on April 16, aiming to raise awareness regarding the danger's elephants face and the various difficulties they have to overcome to live.
- The Day is established by the **Thailand-based Elephant Reintroduction Foundation**.

World Hemophilia Day- 17th April:

- World Hemophilia Day was started by the World Federation of Hemophilia (WHF) and is annually observed on the 17th of April.
- World Hemophilia Day is aimed at raising awareness about haemophilia and other bleeding disorders.
- Theme of 2022 is 'Access for All: Partnership. Policy. Progress. Engaging your government, integrating inherited bleeding disorders into national policy.'

World Heritage Day- 18th April

- Every year, the world observes April 18 as World Heritage Day.
- The theme for World Heritage Day 2022 is "Heritage and Climate".
- The International Day for Monuments and Sites was proposed by the International Council on Monuments and Sites (ICOMOS) on 18 April 1982 and approved by the General Assembly of UNESCO in 1983.

World Liver Day:

- Every year World Liver Day is celebrated on April 19.
- The day is observed to raise awareness about liver diseases across the world.
- The liver is the largest solid organ of the body that removes toxins from the body.

UN Chinese Language Day- 20th April:

• UN Chinese Language Day is observed globally on April 20 every year.

- The day has been chosen to pay tribute to Cangjie, who is a mythical figure who is presumed to have invented Chinese characters about 5,000 years ago.
- The 1st Chinese Language Day was celebrated in 2010 on the 12th of November, but since 2011 the date has been on the 20th of April.

National Civil Services Day-21 April:

- Every year on April 21, the Government of India commemorates 'Civil Services Day' as an opportunity for
 city officials to recommit themselves to the cause of citizens and renew their vows to public service and
 work excellence.
- The day was chosen to remember the day in 1947 when Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, the first Home Minister
 of Independent India.
- The first such event took place on April 21, 2006, at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi.

World Creativity and Innovation Day- 21st April:

- The UN-designated 21 April to be celebrated World Creativity and Innovation Day in order to raise awareness about the crucial role of creativity and innovation in different aspects of human development.
- World Creativity and Innovation Day (WCID) was founded on 25 May 2001 in Toronto, Canada.
- The founder of the day was the Canadian Marci Segal.

International Mother Earth Day -22 April

- Earth Day is observed on April 22 aims to spread awareness about issues, including pollution, deforestation and global warming.
- The theme for Earth Day 2022 is "Invest In our Planet" calling for businesses to shift towards sustainable practices.
- The United Nations celebrates the day as International Mother Earth Day.
- It will mark the day with a "Harmony with Nature" theme.

World Book and Copyright Day -23rd April

- Every year on April 23, World Book and Copyright Day is observed to promote the love of reading.
- World Book Day, also known as World Book and Copyright Day or International Day of the Book, is an
 annual event organized by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO)
 to promote reading, publishing, and copyright.
- The first World Book Day was celebrated on 23 April in 1995, and continues to be recognized on that day.

English Language and Spanish Language Day-23rd April 2022:

- UN Spanish Language Day is observed annually on 23 April.
- The event was established by the UN's Department of Public Information in 2010.

• The purpose of the **UN's language days** is to celebrate multilingualism and cultural diversity as well as to promote equal use of all six official languages throughout the Organization.

National Panchayati Raj Day-24th April

- Every year, April 24 is observed as National Panchayati Raj Day (NPRD) by the Ministry of Panchayati Raj
 to celebrate the constitutional status accorded to the Panchayati Raj system in the country.
- Objective: to increase awareness about Panchayats and Gram Sabhas, the institutions of the local selfgovernments for the rural areas mandated by the Constitution, and also about their roles, responsibilities, achievements, concerns, resolutions etc.
- The 73rd Constitutional Amendment Act, which was passed in 1992, is also commemorated on this day.
- In 1959, Rajasthan became the first state in India to launch the Panchayati Raj while Andhra Pradesh became the second state to launch the system.

International Day of Multilateralism and Diplomacy for Peace-24th April:

- The International Day of Multilateralism and Diplomacy for Peace is celebrated annually on 24 April.
- It seeks to reaffirm the UN Charter and its principles of resolving disputes among countries through peaceful means.
- The Day acknowledges the use of multilateral decision-making and diplomacy in achieving peaceful resolutions to conflicts among nations.
- It was established on 12 December 2018 and was first observed on 24 April 2019.

World Malaria Day- 25th April

- World Malaria Day is observed on 25 April every year.
- The theme for World Malaria Day this year is "Harness innovation to reduce the malaria disease burden and save lives".
- The World Health Assembly first marked World Malaria Day in May 2007 in its 60th session

International Chernobyl Disaster Remembrance Day - 26th April:

- Every year on April 26th, International Chernobyl Disaster Remembrance Day marks the anniversary of this historic nuclear accident.
- The day also focuses on the prevention of future nuclear disasters.
- After the 30th anniversary of the accident, on December 8, 2016, the United Nations adopted the resolution and proclaimed April 26 as the International Chernobyl Disaster Remembrance Day.

World Intellectual Property Day - April 26th

• Every year, on April 26, people throughout the world celebrate World Intellectual Property Day.

- The purpose of the day is to create public awareness about the importance of intellectual property rights, including patents, copyright, trademarks, and designs.
- This year, World Intellectual Property Day 2022's theme focuses on "IP and Youth innovating for a Better Future."

International Delegate's Day – 25th April:

- International Delegates Day is observed every year on April 25th.
- This day is celebrated to raise awareness of the role of representatives and delegates from the Member
 States at the United Nations.
- International Delegates Day commemorates the first day of the San Francisco Conference, also known as the United Nations Conference on International Organization.

World Immunization Week 2022 - 24 to 30 April

- World Immunization Week, celebrated in the last week of April, aims to highlight the collective action needed and to promote the use of vaccines to protect people of all ages against disease.
- To commemorate the day, WHO has decided on the theme of 2022 Immunization Week as "Long Life for All".

International Girls in ICT Day -28th April

- The fourth Thursday in April is designated as International Girls in ICT Day.
- This year's International Girls in ICT Day is April 28th, 2022.
- The theme for this year is "Access and safety."

World Day for Safety and Health at Work- 28th April

- The World Day for Safety and Health at Work is celebrated annually on 28 April to promote the prevention of occupational accidents and diseases globally.
- The theme for this year's World Day for Safety and Health at Work 2022 is "Act together to build a positive safety and health culture".
- 28 April is also the International Commemoration Day for Dead and Injured Workers organized worldwide by the trade union movement since 1996.

World Stationery Day - 27th April:

- World Stationery Day is celebrated every year on the last Wednesday of April.
- This year World Stationery Day 2022 is observed on the 27th of April.
- World Stationery Day is celebrated every year since 2012 to honour the 800th anniversary of the creation
 of the Magna Carta which is one of the most important written documents in British history.

Centre approves over Rs 433 crores Legacy Waste Remediation proposal of Maharashtra:

Housing and Urban Affairs Ministry has approved over 433 crore rupees for 28 Urban Local bodies in
Maharashtra to effectively managing the Solid Waste Management. Garbage Dumpsites have become a
massive problem for most urban cities, Maharashtra's Greater Mumbai holds the maximum amount of
legacy waste in the state.

Cabinet approves over Rs 6062 crore, World Bank assisted programme on Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance:

• The Union Cabinet has approved **808 million dollars or over Six thousand 62 crore** rupees, **World Bank** as sisted programme on Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance RAMP.

Cabinet Committee on Security approves procurement of 15 Light Combat Helicopters Limited Series from HAL for Indian Air Force:

- The Cabinet Committee on Security, CCS has approved procurement of 15 Light Combat
 Helicopter Limited Series Production at the cost of three thousand 887 crore rupees.
- The CCS met under the Chairmanship of Prime Minister Narendra Modi in New Delhi.

Govt approves release of additional installment of 3% of DA to Central Govt employees, DR to pensioner from 1 January 2022:

Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved the release of an additional
instalment of three Percent of dearness allowance, DA to Central Government employees and dearness
relief to pensioners from the first of January 2022.

Centre launches auction of 122 Coal and Lignite mines:

- Coal and Mines Minister Pralhad Joshi has launched an auction of 122 Coal and Lignite Mines including
 18 New Mines.
- Addressing the fifth tranche of auction launch in New Delhi, Mr Joshi, that 42 coal mines have already been auctioned successfully.

Home Ministry's High-Level Committee approves additional Central assistance of over Rs 1,887 crores to 5 States:

- The High-Level Committee under the Chairmanship of Home
- Minister Amit Shah has approved additional Central assistance of over one thousand 887 crore rupees to five States under the National Disaster Response Fund.

National Dairy Development Board in collaboration with the National Bee Board organized National Conclave on 'Production of Bees Wax':

A National Conclave on "Production of Bees Wax" was organized by National Dairy Development
Board (NDDB), Gujarat in collaboration with the National Bee Board (NBB), Ministry of Agriculture
and Farmers Welfare on 30th March, 2022.

Housing and Urban Affairs Ministry approves construction of two lakh 42 thousand houses under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban):

- Housing and Urban Affairs Ministry has approved the construction of two lakh 42 thousand houses in six states under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban).
- These states are Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Tripura, Tamil Nadu and West Bengal.

Doordarshan FreeDish becomes largest DTH platform with reach of over 43 million households:

- Doordarshan FreeDish has become the largest DTH platform with reach of more than 43 million households.
- Information and Broadcasting Ministry, the free DTH service of Doordarshan clocked stellar growth of almost 100 per cent from 22 Million in 2017 to 43 Million in 2022.

PM Modi inaugurates development projects worth Rs 22,000 crore in Dahod, Gujarat:

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has laid the foundation stone and inaugurated the various development projects worth 22,000 crore rupees at a special function organised at Dahod in Gujarat.
- This includes the manufacturing project of 9,000 HP Electric Locomotives at the Railway Production Unit in Dahod.

India's first pure green hydrogen plant commissioned in Assam:

- Oil India Limited (OIL) has taken the first significant step towards the Green Hydrogen Economy in India
 by commissioning India's First 99.999% pure Green Hydrogen pilot plant, with an installed capacity of 10
 kg per day at its Jorhat Pump Station in Assam.
- Shri Sushil Chandra Mishra, Chairman & Managing Director, inaugurated the plant.
- The plant produces Green Hydrogen from the electricity generated by the existing 500kW Solar plant using a 100 kW Anion Exchange Membrane (AEM) Electrolyser array.

Mobile app for 2nd Khelo India University Games launched:

The second edition of the Khelo India University Games to be held in the tech capital of Bengaluru will
have its own mobile app.

- This app launched is a single point reference for all the information on the University games to be inaugurated by Vice President M Venkaiah Naidu on 24th April.
- Post-Covid third wave, this will be India's first largest sporting event with the participation of over 4500 sportspersons from 189 Universities in 20 disciplines.
- The event will be held till May 3rd.

Vice President Venkaiah Naidu to inaugurate Khelo India University Games in Bengaluru on 24th April:

- The Khelo India University Games set to be inaugurated by Vice President M Venkaiah Naidu in Bengaluru on April 24 will see the participation of Olympians.
- According to the Sports Authority of India, Tokyo Olympians Srihari Nataraj representing Swimming, Manu
 Bhaker in Shooting, and Dutee Chand in Athletics will be competing in the Games.
- During the second edition of the games, two new disciplines namely Yogasana and Mallakhamb are added for the first time.

NITI Aayog, UNICEF India sign Statement of Intent on SDGs with focus on children:

- NITI Aayog and UNICEF India signed a Statement of Intent on the Sustainable Development Goals
 (SDGs) with a focus on children.
- This seeks to formalize a framework of cooperation to launch the first report on the State of India's
 Children Status and Trends in Multidimensional Child Development.
- NITI Aayog Vice-Chairman Dr Rajiv Kumar, this new initiative is built on the ethos of SDG attainments for children and ensuring that no child is left behind.

Narendra Singh Tomar inaugurates a nationwide meeting on agriculture for the 2022 Kharif campaign:

- Union Agriculture Minister Shri Narendra Singh Tomar has launched the National Conference on Agriculture for the Kharif Campaign 2022-23 at the NASC Complex in New Delhi.
- According to the 2nd Advance Estimates (2021-22), total food grain production in the country will reach
 3160 lakh tonnes, a new high.
- The production of pulses and oilseeds will be 269.5 lakh tonnes and 371.5 lakh tonnes, respectively.

PM Modi to inaugurate the 7th edition of Raisina Dialogue on April 25:

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate the seventh edition of Raisina Dialogue on the 25th of April.
- President of the European Union Ursula von Der Leyen will be the chief guest at the Dialogue.
- The three-day event is based on the theme Terranova, impassioned, impatient, imperilled.
- There are six broad thematic pillars of the dialogue including Rethinking Democracy, End of Multilateralism, Water Caucuses, and Achieving Green Transitions.

Rajnath Singh to inaugurate DefConnect 2.0 to woo investors in Delhi:

- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh to inaugurate DefConnect 2.0 organised by Innovations for Defence
 Excellence, Defence Innovation Organisation (iDEX-DIO) in New Delhi.
- It will include sessions with stalwarts of the industry, various announcements and static exhibitions of an array of start-ups supported by iDEX-DIO.
- Toll date, iDEX has launched five rounds of Defence India Start-up Challenges and three rounds of Open Challenges receiving more than 2,000 applications from individual innovators and start-ups.
- The index, launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in 2018, essentially provides a unified platform for various stakeholders in the defence and aerospace sectors.

- The workshop is expected to bring together stakeholders working in the field of innovative agriculture and natural-farming practices from India and abroad.
- Natural farming practices are mostly in harmony with the principles of agroecology advocated by the Food and Agriculture Organization, FAO.

Govt sets target to increase the number of Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras to 10,000 by March 2024:

- The Union Government has set a target to increase the number of Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi
 Kendras to 10,000 by March 2024.
- Chemicals and Fertilizers Ministry said that the government has invited applications to open Janaushadhi
 Kendras in three thousand five hundred 79 Blocks of four hundred six districts of 26 States and Union
 Territories.
- It highlighted that under the scheme, seven hundred 39 districts of the country have been covered and
 eight thousand six hundred ten stores have been opened till March.

India Pharmaceutical and Medical Device Conference 2022 to be held on April 25:

- The 7th edition of the India Pharmaceutical and Medical Device Conference 2022 will be held in New Delhi.
- The theme of the three-day conference is Vision 2047: Transformative roadmap for the future.

Apple announces partnership for protection, conservation of mangroves in Maharashtra:

- Apple has announced a new partnership with the Applied Environmental Research Foundation and
 Conservation International to protect the mangrove ecosystem and the livelihoods that depend on it in the
 Raigad district of Maharashtra.
- Apple awarded a grant to the **Applied Environmental Research Foundation (AERF)** in 2021 to work with the local community to protect a **2,400-hectare mangrove forest in the region**.

Union Agriculture Ministry to Iaunch 'Kisan Bhagidari, Prathmikta Hamari' campaign:

- Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare is organizing the 'Kisan Bhagidari, Prathmikta Hamari' campaign.
- The campaign which will continue till 30th April is being organized under 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' in association with various other Ministries and Departments.

Indian Railways augment transportation of Coal through Railways by a record 111 million tonnes during the year 2021-22:

- Indian Railways has augmented the transportation of coal by a record 111 million tonnes and loaded a
 record 653 Million Tonnes of coal in the last financial year with a growth of 20 percent, as compared to 542
 million tonnes in 2021.
- Further from September 2021 to March 2022, the loading of coal to the power sector was augmented by
 32 percent in just 2 quarters.

Government to raise number of Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras to 10,000 by March 2024:

Road Transport and Highways Minister Nitin Gadkari has inaugurated seven National Highway Projects
worth 5569 crore rupees in Aurangabad, Maharastra.

The soil extracted from the ponds developed in Adgaon-Gandheli, Nakshatrawadi and Valmi areas,
 Teesgaon as well as Sajapur village areas have got double benefit.

NITI Aayog released a draft battery swapping policy for 2022:

- Government think tank Niti Aayog has released a draft battery swapping policy under which all
 metropolitan cities with a population above 40 lakh will be prioritised for the development of a battery
 swapping network under the first phase.
- All major cities such as state capitals, UT headquarters and cities with a population above 5 lakh will be
 covered under the second phase, given the importance of the two-wheeler and three-wheeler vehicle
 segments in growing cities.

- The Paris Book Festival was inaugurated on 21st April 2022 & India Pavilion at the Paris Book Festival was inaugurated.
- India's participation as a guest of honour at the Paris Book Festival 2022
- The India Pavilion which has been designed by National Institute of Design (NID)

20th edition of India-France Joint Staff talks held in Paris

- On April 12-13, 2022, The 20th edition of India-France Joint Staff talks was held in Paris, France.
- The meeting was co-chaired by **Assistant Chief of Integrated Staff & Air Vice Marshal B Manikantan** and Head of Bilateral Cooperation South/Staff HQ Brigadier General Eric Peltier.
- The discussions focused on new initiatives under the ambit of existing bilateral defence cooperation
 mechanism and strengthening ongoing defence engagements.

This partnership marks a significant step-forward in India-France cooperation for maritime security.

India to provide additional \$500 million to Sri Lanka for fuel

- India will provide an additional \$500 million in financial assistance to Sri Lanka for it to buy fuel.
- Assistance by the IMF will take about six months to come to us and it will come in tranches.
- This will be the **second \$500 million India** has provided in fuel credit to a Sri Lanka government battling the country's worst financial crisis in living memory.
- The first line of credit was used up earlier this month after a shipment of 120,000 tons of diesel and 40,000 tons of petrol.

Estonia hosts the world's largest cyber exercise - Locked Shields 2022

- North Atlantic Treaty Organisation (NATO) Cooperative Cyber Defence Centre of Excellence (CCDCOE)
 organises the Exercise Locked Shields 2022.
- The Locked Shields 2022 is the annual largest and most complex international live-fire cyber defence exercise in the world.
- More than 2,000 participants from 32 countries are practicing the protection of national IT systems and critical infrastructure under the pressure of a large-scale cyberattack.

Telangana To Get World's Largest Electric 3-Wheeler Factory

- Telangana will get its three-wheeler factory soon as California-based Biliti Electric Inc (Biliti) intends to set up the world's largest factory in the state with a production capacity of 240,000 electric vehicles each year.
- There will be two phases in which the facility will be built.
- Phase I will be developed over 13.5 acres with the capability to produce 18,000 vehicles per year and is
 expected to be operational in early 2023.
- Phase 2, the larger facility spread across 200 acres will be operational in 2024.

Assam celebrates Rongali Bohag Bihu Festival

- One of the biggest festivals of Assam, Bohag Bihu or Rongali Bihu, falls in the second week of April every
 year, marking the beginning of the harvest period.
- In 2022 Bohag Bihu observed from April 14 to April 16.
- The word Bihu is derived from the Sanskrit word Bishu, meaning "to ask blessing and prosperity from the Gods" before the harvest season.

Tripura govt launches new industrial investment promotion scheme

- The Tripura government launched the "Tripura Industrial Investment Promotion Incentive Scheme (TIIPIS),
 2022" for the next 5 years with effect from 1 April, 2022 to 31 March, 2027.
- Under this scheme, various subsidies would be provided to companies and Self Help Groups for setting up industries in Tripura.

Minorities Rights Day to be observed annually on Dec 18

- Minister for Minorities Welfare and Non-Resident Tamils Welfare Gingee K S Masthan announced every
 year on December 18 the Tamil Nadu government will observe as Minorities Rights Day at the state level
 and about Rs 2.50 lakh will be earmarked for the purpose.
- A sum of Rs 2.75 crore would be provided as aid to the students.

Rajasthan Becomes First State to Install L-Route Server

- Rajasthan has become the first state in the country to install L-Route server for uninterrupted internet services.
- This server, installed at **Bhamashah State Data Center**, has been installed by the government in association with the **Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN)**.

Shivamogga Airport To Be Named After Karnataka BS Yediyurappa

- Karnataka Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai announced that the under-construction Shivamogga airport
 will be named after former Chief Minister BS Yediyurappa.
- The required proposal, to name the airport after Yediyurappa, will be sent to the civil aviation ministry.
- The project has been taken up under the UDAN (Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik) programme.
- The construction of the airport, which will have the **second longest runway (3,299 m eters)** after Bengaluru airport, began only in 2020.

Maharashtra becomes first state in country to get 100% digital buses with 'Tap In, Tap Out' facility

- Maharashtra State Environment Minister Aaditya Thackeray, inaugurated the city's first completely digital
 bus on the Gateway of India to Churchgate route, with a unique 'Tap-in Tap-out' feature.
- Brihanmumbai Electricity Supply and Transport (BEST) is India's first bus service to go completely digital.
- It provides ease and convenience to the travellers as they can tap-in using their smart card or via the
 'Chalo' app installed in their smartphones.
- Initially, the 'Tap-in Tap-out' feature will be available in two buses only, but service providers are likely to deploy this digital bus service on 200 routes in the city soon.

J&K's Village Palli becomes India's first carbon-neutral panchayat

- The nondescript hamlet of Palli in Jammu and Kashmir's border district of Samba has become the
 country's first 'carbon neutral panchayat' with Prime Minister Narendra Modi dedicating to the nation a 500
 KV solar plant, installed in a record time of nearly three weeks.
- Under the central government's 'Gram Urja Swaraj programme, in all 1,500 solar panels put up in a total
 area of 6,408 square metres will provide clean electricity to 340 houses in the model panchayat.
- The project was completed at a cost of Rs 2.75 crore in a record time.
- The electricity generated will be distributed to the village, having a daily requirement of 2,000 units, through the local power grid station.

India's first radio channel for visually-impaired 'Radio Aksh' launched in Nagpur

- India's first-ever radio channel for the visually impaired, named 'Radio Aksh' has been launched in Nagpur with the Blind Relief Association Nagpur and Samdrushti Kshamata Vikas Avam Anusandhan Mandal (Saksham).
- This concept was created to help the visually-impaired gain seamless access to education resources and audiobooks.
- Unlike FM and AM, Internet Radio has no geographical limits & the Content is pre-recorded.

Jharkhand's Jamtara becomes country's first district with library in every village

- Jamtara in Jharkhand has become the only district in the country where all gram panchayats have community libraries.
- This district with a population of about **eight lakh** has a **total of 118 gram panchayats** under **six blocks** and each panchayat has a well-equipped library which is open for students from **9 a.m. to 5 p.m.**

Agra becomes 1st city to have vacuum-based sewer systems

- Agra has become the first city in the country to have vacuum-based sewer systems used in public places.
- Agra Smart City has connected 240 such houses near the Taj Mahal with vacuum-based sewer where conventional sewer systems can not be used.
- It has been constructed at Rs 5 crore.

Maharashtra launches scheme to offer personal loans for prisoners

- The Maharashtra government launched a scheme to provide personal loans for prisoners.

- Iron Beam is the world's first energy-based weapons system which is developed by the Rafael Advanced
 Defense Systems is using directed-energy weapon systems and can go a long way in providing aerial defence.

Neptune: Ukraine's homemade cruise missile

- Neptune is a Ukrainian anti-ship cruise missile capable of destroying targets within a range of 300 km.&
 was developed by the Luch design bureau.
- Its design is based on the Soviet Kh-35 anti-ship missile, with substantially improved range and electronics.
- The 16-ft long engine-powered missiles can travel at speeds of up to 560mph (900 km/h) and at heights of between nine and 30ft above the surface

China successfully launches Zhongxing-6D satellite

- China sent a new satellite Zhongxing-6D into space from the Xichang Satellite Launch Center in southwest China's Sichuan Province.
- The satellite was launched by a **Long March-3B carrier rocket** and entered the planned orbit successfully.

- The satellite was developed by the China Academy of Space Technology.
- It, built by the Shanghai Academy of Spaceflight Technology, will be used to observe air pollution, greenhouse gases and other environmental elements.
- The launch marked the 415th mission for the Long March series carrier rockets.

SpaceX launches NROL-85 spy satellite

- A Space Exploration Technologies (SpaceX) Falcon 9 rocket has successfully launched a surveillance satellite for the US National Reconnaissance Office (NRO) from the Space Launch Complex-4 East at Vandenberg Space Force Base in California, US.
- The payload, designated NROL-85, was the agency's second mission of the year and the second orbital launch of 2022 from the Western Range.
- This was the **114th** booster successfully recovered by SpaceX & it was the **148th launch** of the Falcon 9 and the rocket's **14th** mission of 2022.

China successfully launches new satellite Gaofen-3 03 for Earth observation

- On April 07, 2022, China launched a new Earth observation satellite Gaofen-3 03 from the Jiuquan
 Satellite Launch Center in northwest China by a Long March-4C rocket.
- The launch marks the 414th mission for the Long March series carrier rockets.

IIT Madras launches India's 1st indigenously developed prosthetic knee - Kadam

- Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Madras researchers have launched India's first indigenously developed Polycentric Prosthetic Knee called 'Kadam'.
