India wins bid to host 2023 International Olympic Committee session in Mumbai:

- India won the right to host the 2023 IOC session in Mumbai during the 139th IOC session that was held in Beijing, China, on the sidelines of the Winter Olympics.
- This will be the second time India hosts an IOC session, having done so in 1983 in New Delhi.
