NATIONAL CURRENT AFFAIRS:

1st June 2022:

- The PM declares that the eighth International Day of Yoga's theme is "Yoga for Humanity."

2nd June 2022:

- In Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh, President Ram Nath Kovind opened the 59th Maha Adhiveshan of the Akhil Bhartiya Ayurved Mahasammelan.

6th June 2022:

- The "My Pad My Right programme" was introduced in Leh by Dr. GR Chintala, Chairman of the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD).

This will enable women to contribute to the nation's economic growth. Through the network of self-help groups, award-winning sanitary pad manufacturing equipment will be installed as part of this innovative project.
