1. When has the 'International Translation Day' been celebrated recently?

> 30 September

- This day came into being after the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) passed a resolution on May 24, 2017.
- The resolution was signed by eleven countries after recognising the importance of the role of language professionals and September 30 was chosen to pay tribute to them as it also coincides with the feast of the Bible translator, St. Jerome. He was a priest belonging to Northeastern Italy who translated the Bible Greek Manuscripts of the New Testament into Latin.
- 2022 theme: 'A world without barriers'.
- 2. Which state will develop the world's largest safari park recently?

> Haryana

- Haryana is planning to develop a big Jungle Safari Range near Gurugram.
- This curated safari park will cover an area of 10,000 acres over the Aravalli hill ranges in Haryana's Gurugram and Nuh districts.
- According to a statement by the Haryana Government, this project will be the largest such project in the world.
- Presently the largest curated park outside Africa is situated in the United Arab Emirates' Sharjah. The park in Sharjah opened in February 2020 and covers an area of 2,000 acres.
- 3. Who has topped the Hurun India Under 40 Rich List recently?

Nikkhil Kamat

- Nikhil Kamath, cofounder of Zerodha, topped the 'IIFL Wealth Hurun India 40 & Under Self-Made Rich List 2022' with a net worth of Rs 17,500 crore. Bhavish Aggarwal, the founder of Ola, came in second place (Rs 11,700 crore), and Divyank Turakhia of Media.net in third place (Rs 11,200 crore).
- Kaivalya Vohra, the 19-year-old co-founder of Zepto, the instant grocery app, is the list's youngest self-made entrepreneur.
- 4. Where has Adani Greens recently commissioned the world's largest 'wind solar power plant'?

> Rajasthan

- Adani Green Energy has commissioned a 600 MW wind-solar hybrid power plant in the Indian state of Rajasthan.
- The plant will supply electricity under 25-year power purchase agreements with Solar Energy Corp. of India (SECI) at a rate of INR 2.69/kWh.
- 5. Who has been honoured with 'National Lata Mangeshkar Award' recently?

- Noted playback singers Kumar Sanu and Shailendra Singh and music-composer duo Anand-Milind were conferred with the National Lata Mangeshkar Award for different years.
- They will be presented the prestigious award (on September 28), the birth anniversary of the late legendary singer, at her birthplace Indore.
- State Culture Minister Usha Thakur conferred Shailendra Singh, Anand-Milind, and Kumar Sanu with the award for the years 2019, 2020 and 2021 respectively.

Switzerland

- Recently, India was ranked 40th position out of 132 in the Global Innovation Index (GII) 2022 rankings released by World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO).
- India was ranked 46th position in 2021, and 81st rank in 2015.
- Switzerland is the most innovative economy in the world in 2022 for the 12th year in a row followed by the United States, Sweden, the United Kingdom and the Netherlands.
- China is nearing the top 10 while Türkiye and India enter the top 40 for the first time.
- 7. Which Indian has recently been included in Time magazine's list of 100 emerging leaders?

Akash Ambani

- Akash Ambani, son of billionaire Mukesh Ambani and head of India's largest telecom firm Jio, has been named in the Time 100 Next - the magazine's list of world's rising stars.
- 8. Recently which state's Pullampara Panchayat has become the first digitally literate Panchayat in the country?

Kerala

- Pullampara became the first gram panchayat in the country to attain full digital literacy among its residents.
- The 'Digi Pullampara' project was launched on August 15, 2021 to impart digital education to the most underprivileged sections of society in the panchayat. The project was run with the

assistance of volunteers from five engineering colleges, Kudumbashree units and other self-help groups.

Garuda

- The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) this week launched a massive crackdown on narcotics networks with global footprints along with states' police and arrested at least 175 people.
- As many as 127 first information reports (FIRs) were filed by the two agencies involved in 'Operation Garuda' that was carried out to "disrupt, degrade and dismantle" drug networks with international linkages, the CBI said in a statement.

- The International Day of Non-Violence is observed on 2 October, the birthday of Mahatma Gandhi, leader of the Indian independence movement and pioneer of the philosophy and strategy of nonviolence.
- According to General Assembly resolution A/RES/61/271 of 15 June 2007, which established the commemoration, the International Day is an occasion to "disseminate the message of non-violence, including through education and public awareness". The resolution reaffirms "the universal relevance of the principle of non-violence" and the desire "to secure a culture of peace, tolerance, understanding and non-violence".

- World Habitat Day was first celebrated in 1986 with the theme "Shelter is My Right"
- The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) celebrated World Habitat Day 2022 at Vigyan Bhawan.
- Theme of WHD 2022: "Mind the Gap. Leave No One Behind and No Place Behind."
- 19. Which has been declared as the cleanest state of the country in Swachh Survekshan 2022 recently?

Madhya Pradesh

- Madhya Pradesh has secured the first position, followed by Chhattisgarh and Maharashtra in the category of best performing states in 'Swachh Survekshan Awards 2022'.

- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh formally inducted the indigenously-developed Light Combat Helicopters (LCH) in the Indian Air Force at a ceremony held at Air Force Station, Jodhpur in Rajasthan. LCH would be inducted into the 143 Helicopter Unit. LCH has been named as 'Prachanda'.
- Addressing the ceremony, Mr. Singh said induction of LCH not only adds to the combat capability of the Air Force but is also a great leap towards the goal of Atmanirbhar Bharat. He added that the need for a combat helicopter was seriously felt during the Kargil War and LCH is a culmination of two decades of effort to address this need.
- LCH has been developed by Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd (HAL). It is a state-of-the-art modern combat helicopter, primarily designed for deployment in high-altitude regions. LCH is the only attack helicopter in the world which can land and take-off at an altitude of 5,000 m with a considerable load of weapons and fuel.

- Dr. AK Anil Kumar, a senior scientist at the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has been elected as the Vice-President of the International Astronautical Federation (IAF).

- Jharkhand and West Bengal are the only two states in the country where more than half of the women are married before attaining the age of 21 years.
- The survey said that while 54.9 per cent of girls are married in West Bengal before attaining the age of 21 years, the figure for Jharkhand is 54.6 per cent as against the national average of 29.5 per cent.

New Zealand

- The Royal New Zealand navy and the Indian navy have signed a contract on the exchange of White Shipping Information Exchange.

- Germany's coalition government has agreed on a plan to legalise recreational cannabis use among adults.
- Possession of up to 30g (1oz) for personal use would be allowed. Licensed shops and pharmacies would sell it.
- The plan has yet to be approved in parliament but also receive the green light by the European Commission. Health Minister Karl Lauterbach said the plan could become law in 2024.
- In the EU only Malta has legalised recreational cannabis.

- The German plan would also allow home cultivation of three cannabis plants per adult.
- The move was envisaged in the coalition government's manifesto, announced last year. The Social Democrats (SPD) lead the coalition, with the Greens and liberal Free Democrats as partners.
- Several countries have legalised limited use of medicinal cannabis. Canada and Uruguay have also legalised recreational cannabis.
- In the US, 37 states and Washington DC have legalised medical cannabis, while 19 states have approved it for recreational use. That represents well over 40% of the US population.
